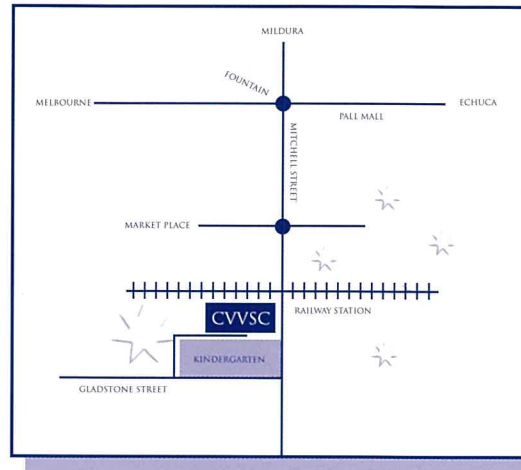


SOME FACTS ABOUT CVVSC!!

HOW TO FIND US



We are in one of the buildings on Platform 2 of the Bendigo Railway Station, on the OPPOSITE SIDE of the station to "Marketplace" shopping centre.
